### 6 MONTH EDUCATION VISAS

Study part-time for 6 months and obtain a Student Visa in Bangkok. Learn Asian culinary arts and Pastry/Bakery at a licensed Ministry of Education private culinary school. Training and recipes are in English.

## TRAINING PROGRAMS

### PAN-ASIAN CULINARY



#### SKILLS YOU WILL LEARN:

- Learn to prepare Thai, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Vietnamese cuisines
- Basic culinary skills (use of a knife, HACCP, etc)
- Asian ingredients
- Use of woks and kitchen equipment
- Professional plating

### PASTRY/BAKERY ARTS



#### SKILLS YOU WILL LEARN:

- Modern pastry techniques
- Bread, dough, and pizza crust making
- Classic cakes, pies, desserts
- Cake decorating
- Working with chocolates
- Learn 101 recipes

### HOW IT WORKS:

- Each course is 6 months in duration
- Part-time attendance during the week is necessary
- Course completed in 6 months

# TRAINING PROGRAM OPTIONS & COSTS

1. **Non-Diploma**— 30,000 THB, attend weekly part-time without earning a diploma
2. **Diploma**--60,000 THB, attend weekly part-time, and earn a recognized diploma



## How to Register

1. Select the date you wish to start
2. Contact us to confirm availability.
3. Once your start date is confirmed, a deposit is required.

## Student Visa Procedure

1. Complete Ministry of Education papers provided by us.
2. Return completed forms, and we will submit to MOE for approval. This usually takes about 3 weeks.
3. Upon return of approved documents to you, take to Thai Embassy in another country for an Education Visa.

## Payment for Class

1. Deposit-- 9,000 THB, paid using any major credit card (+3%) or bank transfer (non-refundable)
2. Remaining balance--Due when we provide approved MOE documents, paid in cash or credit card (+3%) at the school.

Diploma & Ministry of Education certificate-- provided upon course completion.
